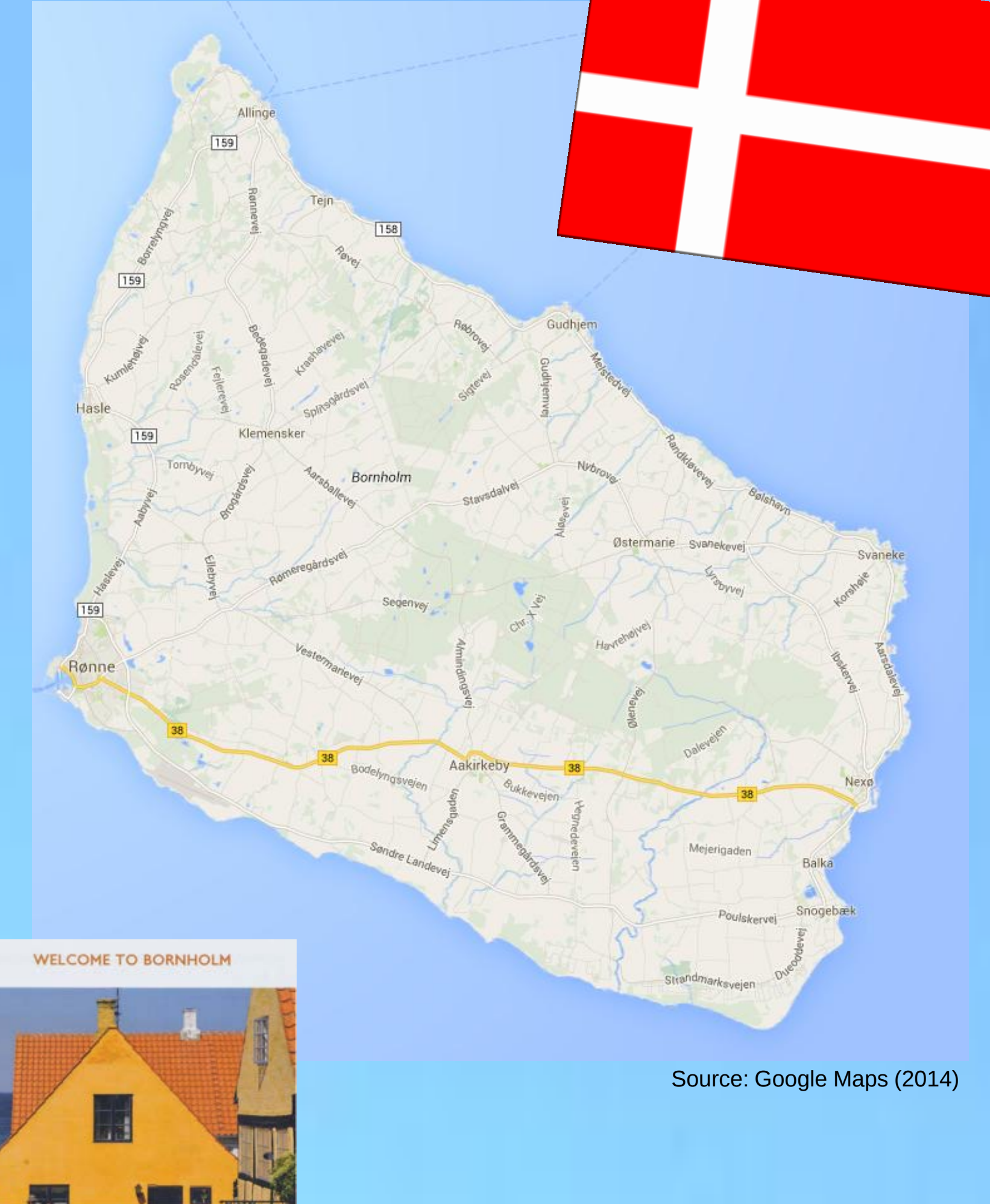
The resort or reference to a wide array of research techniques and of both qualitative and quantitative methodologies, were strongly encouraged.
