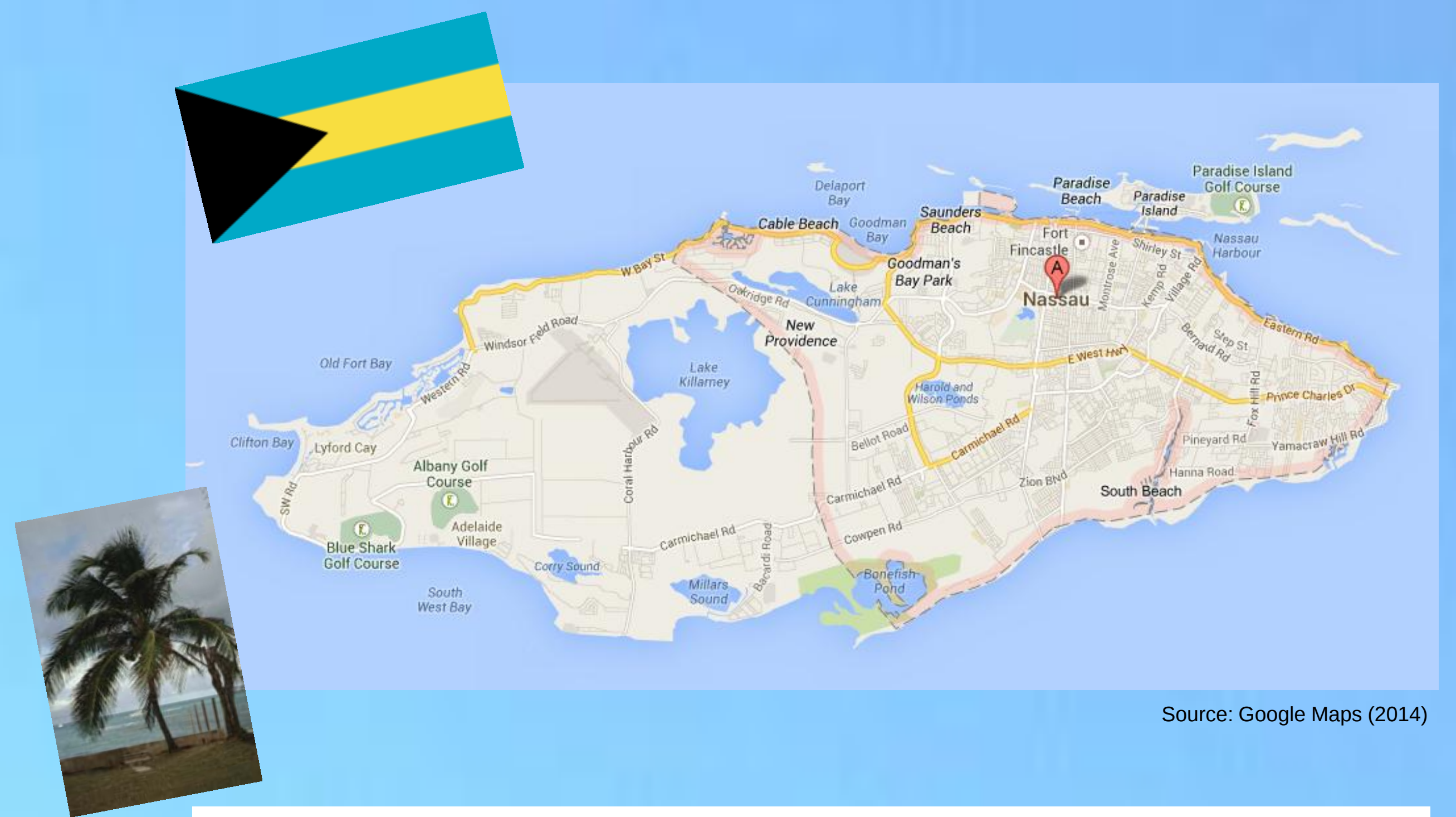

Description of Island III

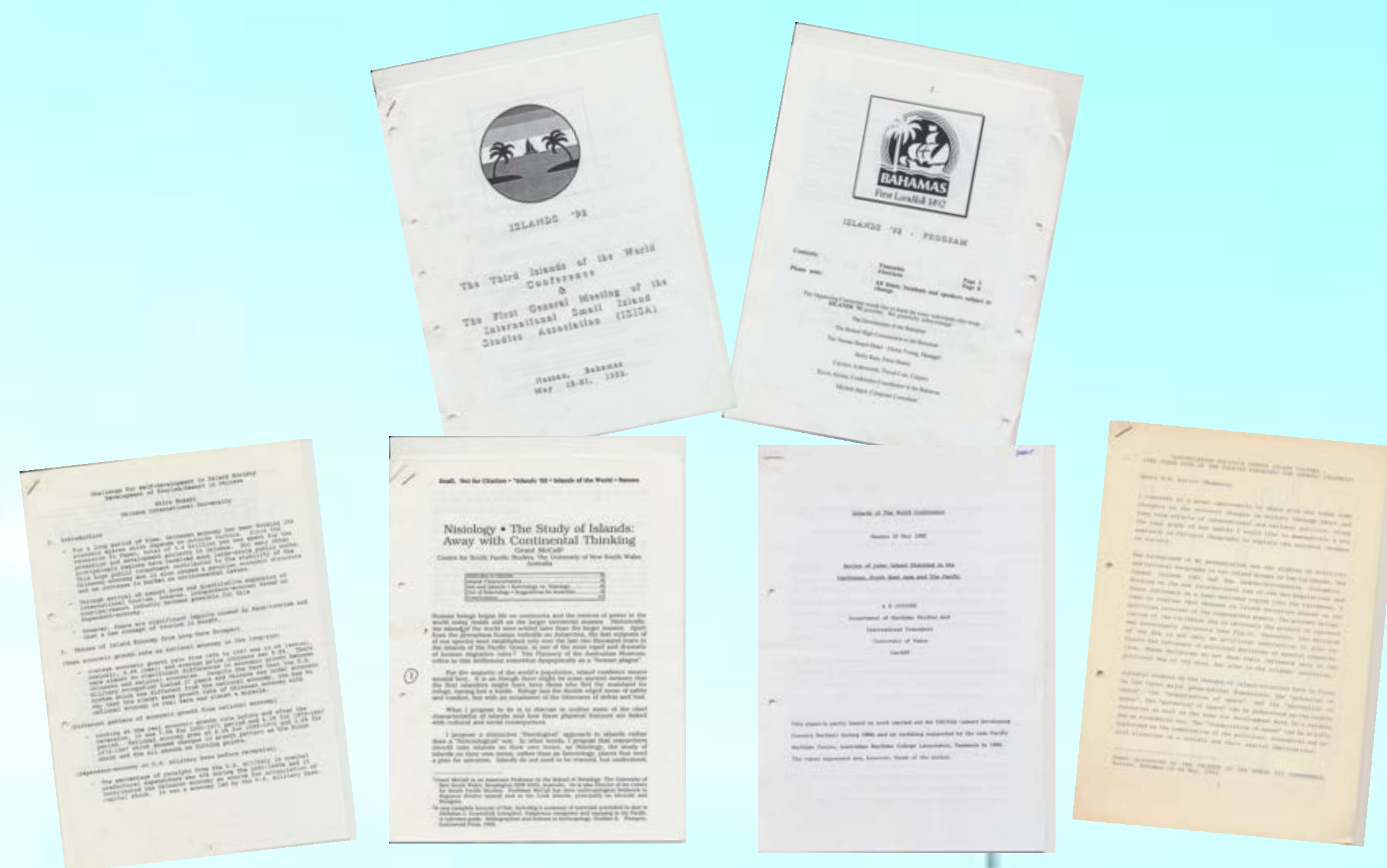

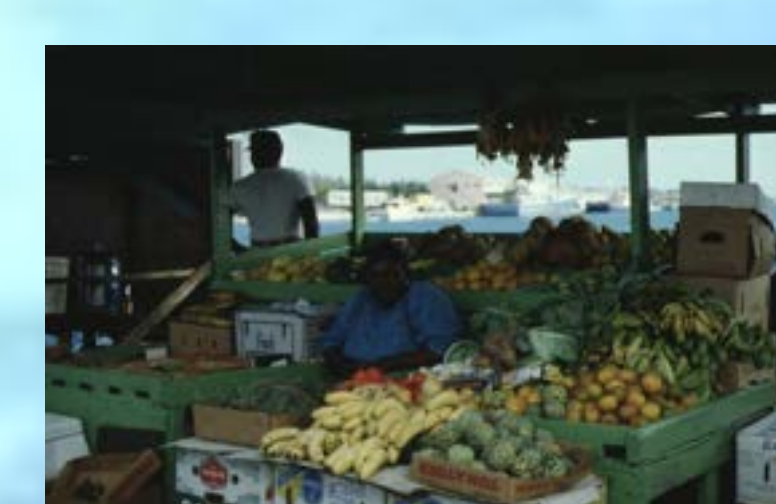
